SCMHCC Supported Employment Youth Transition Program

Vision:

Select young people who meet SED criteria and help them develop skills as we prepare them for the work place of today.

SCMHCC Supported Employment Youth Transition Program Goal:

Each young person will become competitively employed and for businesses to gain motivated productive employees.

Target Population:

SED youth (16-18 y/o) receiving children services at SCMHCC.



Job Placement:

Recommendations will be based on matching youth with jobs according to their abilities and their interests.

Supported Employment Uses a Team Approach:

Employment specialists meet with mental health practitioners to talk about strategies to help youth succeed at their education and employment goals. Although the employment specialist is the central person who provides assistance with jobs and school, other people on the team also help. Mental health practitioners may include case managers, therapists, attendant care workers and psychiatrists.

What is Competitive Employment:

Competitive employment is defined as a job that any person can apply for, not a job designated for people who have disabilities.
