### **About B.E.A.N:**

- **ButlerEarlyAccessNetwork.org** links parents to early childhood news, education, resources, and services available in Butler County and parts of Wichita, KS.
- Provides online access to the **ASQ:SE-2** to screen your child's social-emotional readiness as early as 2 months, and up to 5 years of age.
- Once you complete the online screen, you will be mailed the results within 2 weeks.  
  
*If screen results indicate a potential need for follow-up, a B.E.A.N. representative will contact you to review further and offer personalized support.*
- Provides **Edinburgh Post-natal Depression Screen (EPDS)** to new and expectant mothers, with resources on where to go if you need support.

### **What is the ASQ:SE-2?**

- **ASQ: SE-2** stands for Ages and Stages Questionnaire: Social and Emotional
- **ASQ: SE-2** is a parent completed questionnaire that assesses your child's development in the areas of self-regulation, compliance, communication, adaptive, autonomy, affect and interaction with people.
- Corresponds with regular check-up ages of 6, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 48 and 60 months.
- The **ASQ: SE-2** system is recognized as a national standard in screening.
- About 30 items per screen.
- Takes about 10-15 minutes to complete.



### **What is the Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Screen (EPDS)?**

- The **EPDS** is a quick and simple questionnaire that can indicate whether you have symptoms common in women with depression and anxiety during pregnancy, and in the year following the birth of a child.

*This is not intended to provide a diagnosis – only trained health professionals should do this.*
