## **ADULT COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES (CSS)**



# WHAT IS CSS?

CSS is for adults 18 years old and up that meet SPMI criteria and/or other eligibility requirements who can benefit from working with Case Managers in the community to help manage symptoms, improve daily living skills, and work to recovery. A referral is made by a Clinician, usually at time of intake.

## AVAILABLE SUPPORTS:

- **Peer Support**

Helps consumer to develop a network for information and support from others that have been through similar experiences, assists consumers with regaining the ability to make independent choices and take a proactive role in their treatment, and assists the consumer with identifying and effectively responding to triggers that may cause difficulty in day to day life.

- **Psychosocial Rehabilitation Groups**

Various topics including social skills, life skills, coping skills, exercise/health, IDDT and more.

- **Psychosocial Rehabilitation/Attendant Care**

Assists consumer with compensating for/eliminating difficulties resulting from illness, development of daily living skills and routines and assistance with development of social and interpersonal and other learned skills. Provides teaching of skills of daily tasks, activities, or routines to promote independence.

- **SOAR**

Program designed to serve adults who are homeless or at risk for homelessness, and who have a mental illness, co-occurring mental health, substance use disorders, and other serious health condition apply for benefits/disability.

- **Support Employment**

Assists consumer in finding a job that fits the consumer's needs and interests and supports consumer following the job start.

- **Target Case Management and Health Coordinator TCM**

Facilitates the treatment team planning process, makes collateral contacts with those involved in the consumer's care and helping with the specific consumer's needs, assists individuals in obtaining access to needed medical, social, educational, and other services, and coordinates services to assure a integrated, comprehensive plan.

- **Community Support Psychiatric Treatment**

Helps in identifying negative symptoms of mental illness, develops strategies to minimize effects of mental illness, utilization of solution focused interventions and skills to problem-solve difficulties, utilization of resources, crisis management, and use of strengths-based tools.
