



What is Social Stars Learning Center?

Social Stars Learning Center is a Preschool program designed for children ages 3 to 6 who are struggling to manage their emotions or display age-appropriate social skills. It is a program developed to work within the preschool classroom focusing on assisting those students with a need for extra support to maintain and excel in the classroom setting. Improving chances of future academic success, as well as improving skills needed to succeed in the home and other community settings.

Presenting difficulties might include:

- Aggressive behaviors
- Poor Social Skills
- Difficulty following rules
- Problems with attention and concentration
- Frequent tantrums
- Extreme Anxiety
- Prior behavioral problems in day care settings

Social Stars Learning Center is a preschool program that strives to provide children with an opportunity to learn and apply the skills necessary to excel in life.



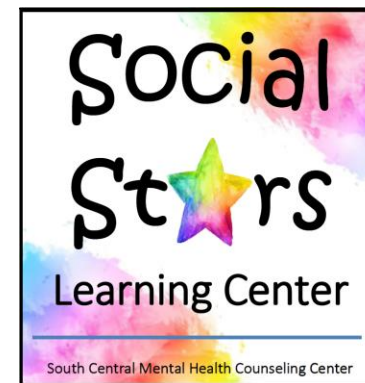
Prevent:

Social Stars Learning Center curriculum

Conscious Discipline® is a comprehensive classroom management program and a social-emotional curriculum. It is based on current brain research, child development information, and developmentally appropriate practices.

Frog Street Pre-K is a comprehensive, research-based program that integrates instruction across developmental domains and early learning disciplines.



Advantages over Traditional Preschools/Centers:

- ★ Smaller child/teacher ratio; 4 children to each staff member.
- ★ Conscious Discipline based classrooms.
- ★ Treatment team has ability to observe the child in a classroom setting.
- ★ Primary focus is on the Social and Emotional needs of the child.
- ★ Play Therapy room on site.
- ★ Sensory room

How do I enroll my child?

Step 1: Attend an intake appointment.

During the intake appointment it will be determined if the child meets the criteria necessary to qualify for Social Stars.

Step 2: If your child's therapist believes Social Stars would be an appropriate fit, a Social Stars representative will contact you to complete an initial assessment.

Step 3: An initial Treatment plan meeting will be held the same day as your child's first day of school. This meeting will develop the child's goals, strengths, and needs.
